

Pannon Community Hub
Veszprém, Egyetem Street (Egyetem utca)
University of Pannonia, Building 'E'

Access from Veszprém railway station and bus station by public transport:

Pannon Community Hub is directly accessible from the railway station and the bus station by local bus. The local buses 4 and 4A run to the University Street (Egyetem utca). The nearest stop to the Community Hub is Komakút Square (Komakút tér). The building is about 2-3 minutes' walk from the bus stop, on the same side as the bus stop. Once you have to cross the street on a pedestrian crossing half way between the bus stop and the building.

How to get there: the main entrance is from University Street (Egyetem utca), you have to walk up a few steps, then you will reach the stairs. After walking up on the stairs, you can enter the building, from where you can access the rooms. The men's room is the second room on the left, the women's is further away. From the entrance, you go straight ahead to reach the public areas. At the entrance, walk straight for about 10 metres and then turn left on the corridor to enter the spacious, artificial grass-covered room. If you turn right along the corridor, you will find several smaller rooms. If you want to go upstairs, after entering the building through the main entrance, walk forward for about 5 metres, turn left and you will reach the stairs. The building has 2 floors, the ground floor and the first floor. On the first floor is the so-called Chamber room (Kamaraterem). When you reach the stairs, turn right, and then a few steps to the Chamber room mentioned above.

The barrier-free entrance is located to the left of the main entrance on Egyetem Street. If the entrance is closed, you can contact the Pannon Community Hub staff, who also have a key to the gate. There is a bell on the fence, press this to call the reception of building B, from where the security comes and opens the gate.) Go through the gate, take the long ramp up to the terrace, turn right and to enter the open door into the large, artificial grass-covered Community Space of Building E. From there, you can reach the rooms on the ground floor. There is no elevator in the building. The Chamber Room upstairs is not accessible. In Building E, Braille signs are located next to the doors of the rooms at a height of about 150-160 cm to help you find your way.

The rooms of the building are spacious, with wide doors leading into each room. There are toilets on both floors, there are also disabled toilets on the ground floor for ladies and men.
